Election Commission of India (LPA No.522 of 2011 decided on 16 March 2012) relating to dispute between two groups of Akhil Bharatiya Hindu Mahasabha, a registered unrecognized party. In the said Judgment, it has been held that the Commission cannot adjudicate in matter of internal disputes of a registered unrecognized party.
